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ITINERARY

Sunday 20th October: Special coach transportation from Stamford Hill to London Airport. Fly London / Tel Aviv by scheduled IATA Jet services, with meals en route. Meeting and assistance through customs and passport by representatives of GOODMOS TOURS in Israel. Transfer by coach to Jerusalem.

Monday 21st October: Depart for full day tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Drive along the walls of the Old City towards Mount Scopus, with the Old Hebrew University and the Hadassa Medical Centre. Past the British Cemetery of the First World War and along the Mountain Range we arrive to Mount of Olives with its famous ancient Jewish Cemetery. From here, enjoy a breathtaking view of the complete city of Jerusalem. Proceed through the Judean Mountains to Hebron for a visit to Mearath Hamachpela - the Tombs of the Patriarchs. Return past Gush Etzion and King Salomon Pools to Beth Lechem for a visit at Kevev Rachel Imenuh. Return to Jerusalem for lunch.

P.M. Drive to the Old City. Enter through one of the seven gates of the town and walk through the colourful Arab Markets, a part of the Via Dolorosa, visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, walk through the Old Jewish quarter and visit the ruin of the Synagogue of Churvath Rabbi Jehuda Hasid, then on to the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) - time for Mincha. We proceed through the Dung Gate to the Kidron Valley with Abshalom's Pillar and past the Valley of Jehoshafath with Church of all Nations and Gat Semana. Return to hotel.

Tuesday 22nd October: At leisure in Jerusalem.

Wednesday 23rd October: Depart for full day tour of the New City. Drive towards Mt. Herzl and visit the Tomb of Dr. Herzl and the Military Cemetery. On the Yad Vashem Memorial Centre for the six million Jewish People who perished during the Holocaust. Drive through the quarter of Beth Hakerem to the Hebrew University. Drive through the University and visit its unique Synagogue. Proceed past the new Israel Parliament Building. - The Knesseth, and through the various quarters of the town to the hotel for lunch. After lunch we drive to Mount Zion for a visit to King David's Tomb. Then through the orthodox quarter of Mea Shearim to the Israel Museum for a visit at the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed. Transfer to Nathanya.

Thursday 24th October:

until At leisure or optional 2 day Eilat tour (£16.3s.0d.)

Tuesday 29th October:

Wednesday 30th October: Depart for tour of Tel Aviv. Drive through the City's main streets, pass by Z.O.A. House, and the Mann Auditorium, the Helena Rubinstein Pavillion and the National Theatre. Proceed southwards to Jaffa and stroll through the quaint narrow lanes. Tour the antiquities and visit the Museum. Return to Tel Aviv via Bat Yam and ascend to the observation point 'Mitzpe Shalom' (the highest building in Israel). Return to hotel.

Thursday 31st October: At leisure in Nathanya.

Friday 1st November: At leisure in Nathanya.

Saturday 2nd November: At leisure in Nathanya.

Sunday 3rd November: Transfer from hotel in Nathanya to Lod Airport for transportation to London on scheduled IATA jet services, with meals en route. Coach transportation to Stamford Hill.
