ANNUAL REPORT - 1966

This has been a fateful year for our club as we are now fully engaged in the rebuilding of the premises at Cazenove Road and coping with a host of problems brought about by our having to use alternative accommodation for club activities.

We are happy to report that in spite of our temporary exile many activities have carried on thanks to the magnificent assistance and understanding of our valued members and friends. The younger section continued to play Badminton, and the Drama Section only stopped rehearsing when they learned that the stage would be unusable. The leader of this group had his reward when he received his well deserved acclamation from the children of our deaf members who were the guests at a special party arranged by the General Purposes Committee.

There were some fine film shows provided of many kinds including foreign films with English sub-titles all of which were very well received. The Compton (Aid) Committee for the Jewish Deaf, apart from helping us with much needed finance, again invited a large group of our members to a Bowling Alley and also provided a panel for a Brains Trust Evening. Lectures on the Jewish Festivals and other topics of interest were given, and the Club Seder Service attracted a record attendance.

Outings were arranged, and 30 deaf members spent a week-end at the Home of the Association of Jewish Youth in Margate. Other events such as Quiz Evenings, Slide Shows, Whist Drives and similar entertainments received popular support.

The great question now from all our good friends and members is how soon can we get back to our Club? We can promise everyone that every effort is being made to hasten the re-opening and feel sure that members' patience will be well rewarded in due course. The fully heated re-built club with enlarged facilities and increased comfort, achieved at great cost and effort, will provide us for the first time with the capabilities of increasing our service to members and overseas visitors.

We thank the Jewish Blind Society and Victoria Boys' and Girls' Club for their great kindness and hospitality in granting us facilities during our temporary exile. We extend our grateful thanks to our Hon. Officers, Members of the Council and Committees for their loyal support and pay special tribute to our Functions Committee because without their indefatigable work and help, and the assistance of the Compton Committee, we would have found ourselves in dire straits. We also want the many Organisations, Aid Committees, Ladies' Guilds, Lodges and individual supporters and friends to know how deeply we appreciate their generosity and interest during the past difficult year.

Much remains to be done, however, in equipping and furnishing this re-modernisation, and our Executive Committee who are shouldering this heavy burden appeal to you all, who have proved so generous, to once more respond to our appeal for financial assistance.

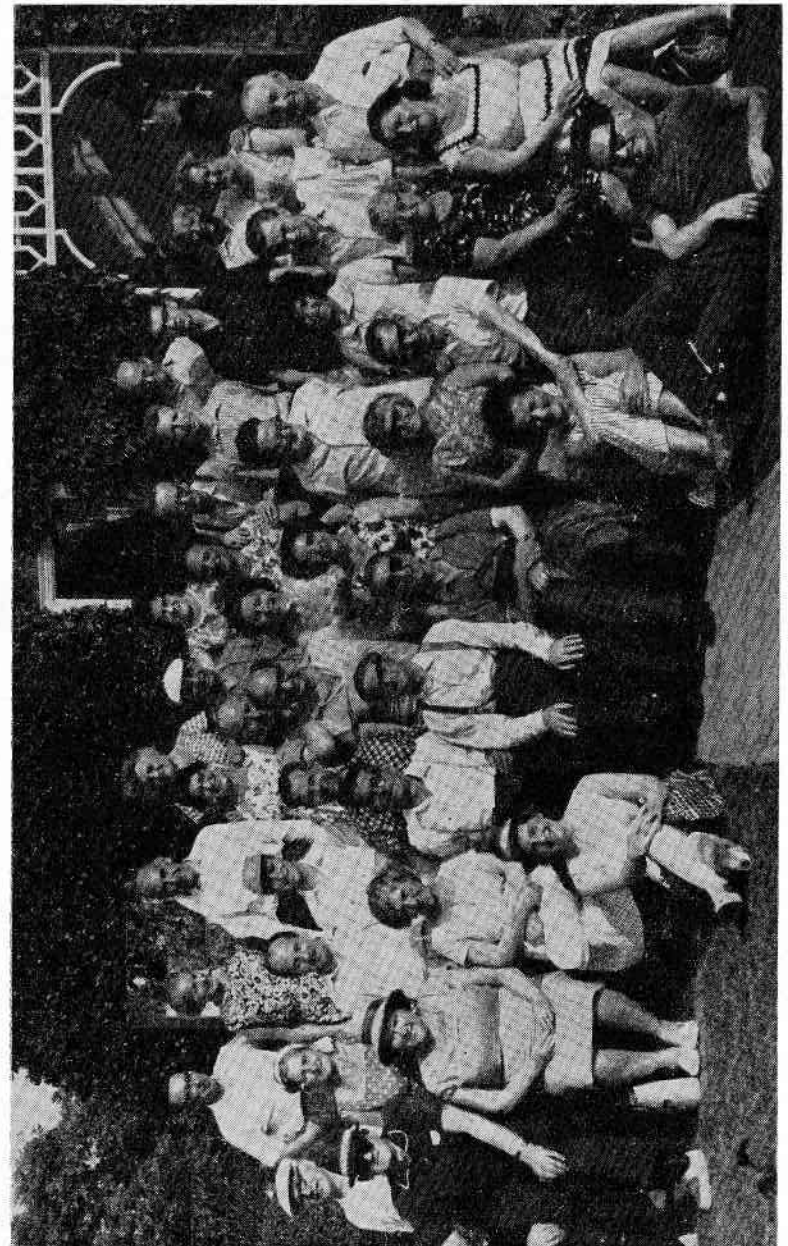

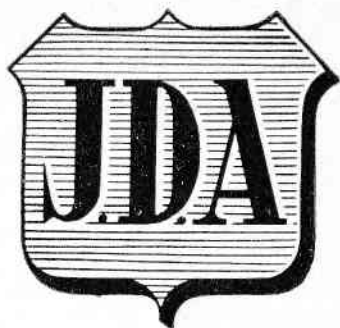
