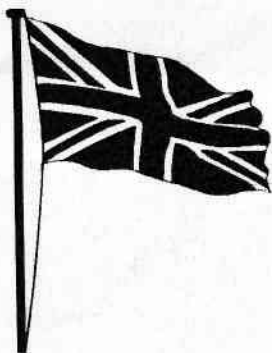

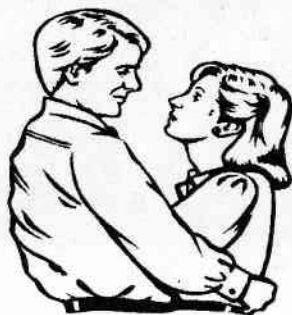


**"Towards

You will have the opportunity to participate in a very full programme to suit all ages and tastes. In addition to the usual seminars in the convention hall, we hope to arrange various activities including:- drama performances; sport matches covering table tennis, five-a-side football, chess, ten-pin bowling & basketball (depending on the number of participants).

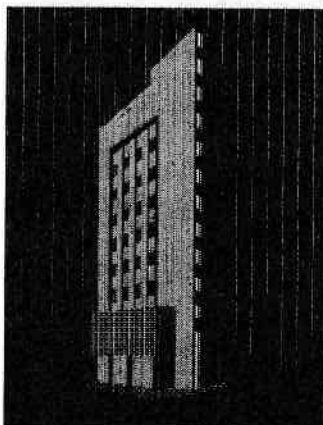
Outings to be arranged are to Windsor Castle, Stonehenge, Bath, and, of course, the various landmarks of London.



There will also be an opportunity to join a special Shabbat package at the hotel particularly for those residing in London.

It will include Shabbat dinner on the Friday night and a special service conducted by a deaf rabbi - this is subject to confirmation.

Accommodation will be at the smart London Olympia Hilton in Kensington, West London - very close to the lively West End.



What is unique about this Congress is its convenience and comfort - everything under one roof! No more walking to and from one hotel to the Congress - that is if you wish to stay at the London Olympia Hilton.

Catering at the hotel will be kosher and there will be a specially-constructed synagogue in one of the large rooms in the hotel.

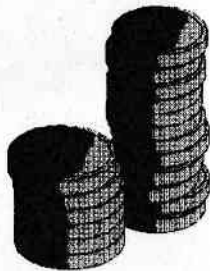
If interested, please attach your abstract on an A4 sheet with your booking form to reserve your place. It must be noted that accepted speakers will qualify for a discount on the Congress fees.

Book your place to avoid disappointment - the rates are kept to a minimum as much as possible to ensure everybody, who want to come, can come!

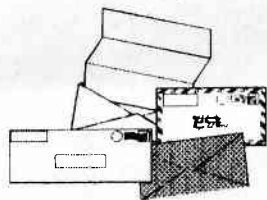
The fee for the congress will be £189.00. This will include registration, luncheon during congress, full programme including the banquet as well as all the social events.
