

LONDON IS CALLING!

The World Organization of Jewish Deaf is becoming "mobile" and will stage its first conference in London, England under the hostship of Jewish Deaf Association. The dates of the conference are September 2-5, 1984.

This conference will bring together ranking professional authorities as well as deaf leaders from other lands to discuss topics pertaining to religion, education, welfare, technology and social activities to benefit the deaf. The theme of the conference is "Jewish Deaf in the Diaspora." In addition there will be a session displaying technical and scientific aids for the deaf under the sponsorship of Royal National Institute of the Deaf.

The site of the activities will be Woburn House, located in central London within easy access from all parts. The Jewish Deaf Association will also be the center of some program activities. Hotels near these two sites are situated in Russell Square, Euston, Tottenham Ct. Road and Kings Cross sections.

Seventy-five dollars (\$75) will be the cost of the entire registration fee which will include admittance to the opening ceremonies, all sessions, tea breaks, lunches, stage show, one coach outing, social night at JDA, brochures, literature, badge. A farewell dinner planned will be extra. In the planning subject to security clearance will be a guided tour of the House of Parliament.

The keynoter will possibly be Chief Rabbi Sir I. Jakobovitis and speakers will be honorary members of the House of Commons.
