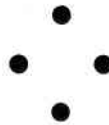
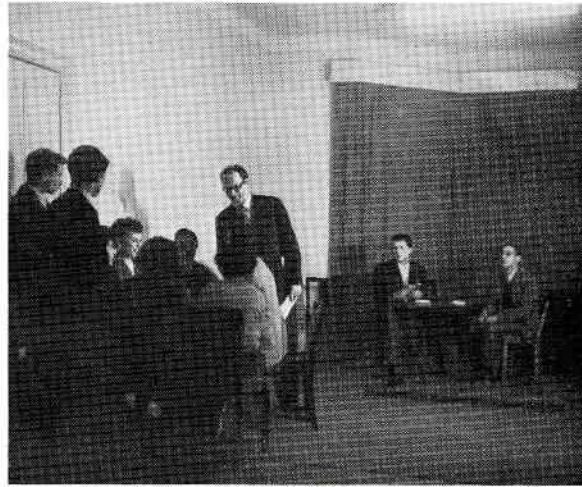
The Chairman and Council thank Mr. Jimmy Cohen very sincerely for his magnificent effort, and trust his interest in the work of the Association will continue.

HISTORY OF THE J.D.A.

Up to five years ago the Deaf Members of the Jewish Community had no centre of their own. They had been attending the Clubs of the Royal Association for the Deaf and Dumb. Missing the Jewish environment and guidance they were in constant danger of assimilation.

A Meeting of Jewish Deaf people was convened at the Anglo-Palestinian Club in April, 1948, and subsequently through the kindness of the Reverend I. Levy, and the courtesy of the Honorary Officers of Hampstead Synagogue they were granted the use of the Synagogue Hall where fortnightly Meetings were held. As a result of these Meetings, the Jewish Deaf Association was founded.

It was by the efforts of the Chairman of this Association and the generosity of Mr. F. Freeder, Chairman of the Joint Synagogues Childrens Hostel Committee that the premises 90/92 Cazenove Road, Stamford Hill, N.16 were donated rent free for seven years.

The Club and Hostel were consecrated by the Chief Rabbi on May 27th, 1951, since when remarkable progress has been made. The membership is now 200 of both sexes, and all ages.

At the Club and Hostel the following amenities are offered:—

COMFORTABLE LOUNGES—where friendships are fostered and cultivated, and where the Deaf are happy being able to communicate with each other.

BILLIARDS, TABLE TENNIS, AND TELEVISION ROOMS.

FACILITIES FOR SOCIAL FUNCTIONS, such as Whist Drives, Dances, Play acting.

RELIGIOUS FESTIVALS ARE OBSERVED—120 Members attended the Seder Service, Purim Party and New Year gathering.

WELFARE AND ADVICE CENTRE—Members are assisted in finding employment if required. Health and general problems are consistently dealt with.

CULTURAL AND EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES—By means of Lectures and Talks through the medium of interpretor.

LEAGUE SPORTS ACTIVITIES are arranged—It is hoped to take some Members to Brussels this year to the Deaf Olympics.

A **KOSHER CANTEEN** is provided where hot meals and snacks are served daily.

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION is available to those who require it, There is a Resident Matron—Mrs D. Margulies—who keeps a watchful and constant eye on every aspect of their comfort.

The Association now has a full time organising Secretary and Welfare Officer, Mr. Ralph Goldstaub, who is the organiser of all the Club activities.

By this means every effort is being made to give members the opportunity of living a full, happy, and as far as possible, a normal life.

It is in fact a Home in every way for the Jewish Deaf, which needs continuous support for its maintenance.

A cordial invitation is extended to all who wish to visit the Club and Hostel.



In the Louis Lesser Canteen a hot meal awaits residents and members after their day's work. Light refreshments and snacks are available at all times.



The Billiard Room, equipped by the Sportsman's Aid Society, is a constant source of enjoyment in which many happy hours are spent.



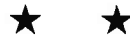
