Correspondence A letter had been received from Mr. & Mrs. I. Ash  
they tendered their resignation, and the Committee agreed that no  
further news-letters be sent to them.

Matters Under Discussion Myer Solomon said that it would be necessary  
to appoint a person who should be responsible for the records and record  
player. He had asked Mr. Margulies whether he would agree to undertake  
this task. Mr. Margulies had explained that it would be much better  
if a Member of the Youth Section would look after the records and the  
gramophones. Myer Solomon also showed to all Members present the portable

on Feb. 15th and a Whist Drive on Feb. 22nd.

Mr. Lionel Katz said that Whist Drives should be arranged by the G.P.C.  
and the Youth Section would of course be welcome as always to take part.  
Mr. Katz' proposal was turned down by the Chairman. He explained that  
the Youth Section had arranged this Whist Drive for Feb. 22nd at one  
of their meetings.

Mrs. Annie Hart asked the Chairman for the number of Members on the  
books. The Hon Treasurer was requested to prepare details ~~xxxxxx~~  
for the next meeting.

The Committee agreed that Members taking part in competitions should be urged to come to the Club more often to finish their games. Infrequent appearances are causing unnecessary delays.
