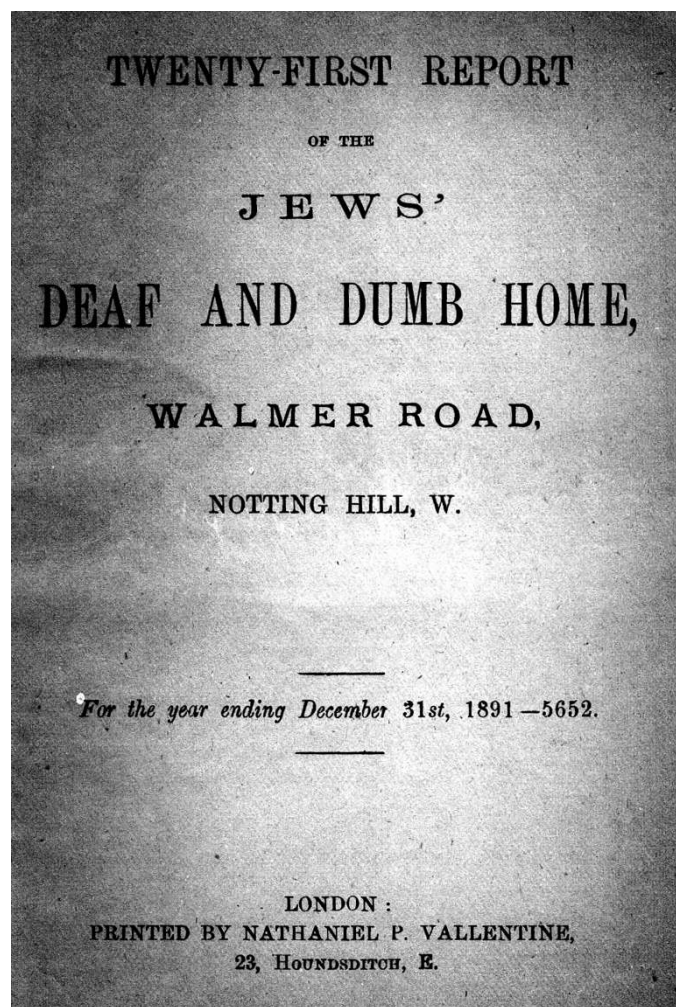


Twenty-First Report of the Jew's Deaf and Dumb Home, Walmer Road, Notting Hill, London 1891



The Jews Deaf and Dumb Home was founded in 1863 by Baroness Mayer de Rothschild as a school where resident Jewish children could learn to speak. Originally in Whitechapel, it moved to Walmer Road, Notting Hill. The first Director was William Van Praagh, from the Netherlands, who had been invited to England to help convert the School from the manual to the oral method of teaching speech.

The Home moved in 1899, to Nightingale Lane, Wandsworth, and closed in 1965. The National Archives has its records from the twentieth century, but this fragile little booklet is older – from 1891. The officers and lists of hundreds of donors with their addresses and donations demonstrate support for this charity from mainly the middle and wealthier classes.

REPORT.

THE Committee in presenting the 21st Annual Report to the Governors and Subscribers of the Jews' Deaf and Dumb Home, have the satisfaction of informing them that the Institution maintains its efficiency. It is a gratifying circumstance that the health of children has been uniformly good during the year.

There are now 29 children (11 girls and 18 boys) receiving instruction in the Home. Four (3 girls and a boy) have been admitted during the past year, while two (a girl and a boy) have left. The boy has since been apprenticed to a chair frame maker. The Institution makes provision for the future of the children committed to its care by affording them technical instruction so as to facilitate the acquirement by them of suitable trades.

Though the annual subscriptions have again fallen off, the donations show an increase of £18 11s. 6d. over those of the previous twelve months. The Committee regret that the appeal made in their last Report has not been answered by the addition of the names of any fresh subscribers. There is much to be desired in this respect, and your Committee feel that some increase in the annual contributions is indispensable

if the Institution is to continue to be satisfactorily conducted.

With a view to increasing the income of the Home, the Committee will recommend to the Governors and Subscribers the advisability of admitting on payment a limited number of non-Jewish day pupils. It is not anticipated that the proposed arrangement will necessitate any addition to the teaching staff, who can well instruct a larger number of children. Steps are also being taken to obtain from the Guardians of the various parishes from which the pupils are drawn a grant towards the cost of their maintenance, etc. The authorities of Whitechapel have already been approached in this matter, and their decision, if favourable, will serve as a precedent for the Guardians of other parishes. By these means the Committee hope to augment the revenue of the Institution.

Although, as will be seen from the balance sheet, there is a large deficit in the funds, the Committee, having regard to the extraordinary calls which are being made upon the generosity of the public, have decided to postpone the Biennial Ball until next year, they trust that their appeal on that occasion will meet with a response that will enable them to pay off the debts now owing to the Bankers and to their former Treasurer, and to start the Home on a new course of usefulness, by providing the means for additional accommodation required for those children who are

seeking admission into the Home, and whose applications have to be deferred for want of sufficient space. It is to be expected, owing to the increase of population, that other applications for admission will follow.

The thanks of the Committee are due to the Director and Staff, and to the Matron for the efficient discharge of their respective duties. Hearty acknowledgments are also due to the Ladies' Committee for their conscientious supervision of the domestic arrangements of the Home.

The Committee in conclusion again earnestly urge the claims of the Charity on the support of the public, without whose co-operation it is impossible for the Institution to be maintained in the furtherance of its benevolent objects.
