ITINERARY

JEWISH DEAF SOCIETY TOUR TO ISRAEL

Sunday : 20th May

Fly London/Tel Aviv by scheduled jet aircraft of El Al Israel Airlines. Meeting and assistance on arrival by Peltours representatives. Transfer to the TOWER HOTEL, JERUSALEM.

Monday : 21st May

Drive through the residential districts to the Hadassah University Medical Centre, to visit its synagogue with the famous Marc Chagall Windows. Visit the Kennedy Memorial and drive on to Yad Vashem, memorial for the Jewish Martyrs of the Second World War. Continue to Mt. Herzl to visit Herzl's Tomb and Military Cemetery, passing the Hebrew University Campus and return to hotel.

In the afternoon, drive to the Jaffa Gate. Visit the Citadel with David's Tower. Walk into the Old City, to the Jewish Quarter and Western (Wailing) Wall. Visit the Dome of the Rock, site of the first and second Temples and walk through the Via Dolorosa to visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Return to hotel.

Tuesday : 22nd May

Leave Jerusalem past the housing estates for new immigrants and drive to Bethlehem, visiting Rachel's Tomb and Church of Nativity. Continue to Hebron to visit the Caves of Machpelah. Return to Jerusalem.

In the afternoon, depart Jerusalem once again, passing Bethany, through the wilderness of Judea and the Good Samaritan's Inn to Jericho. Visit the excavations of the ancient Walls of Jericho and on to Ein Fash'ka, oasis and fresh water rockpool on the shores of the Dead Sea. Return to Jerusalem.

Wednesday : 23rd May

Depart after breakfast and drive north through the Jordan Valley to the biblical city of Beit Shean, visit the Roman Amphitheatre and on to Tiberias. Drive along the shores of the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum to view the ancient ruins of the Synagogue there. CROSS THE SEA OF GALILEE BY BOAT Continue to the Golan Heights, to visit the former Syrian strongholds overlooking the Kinnereth. Visit the Banyas Springs and waterfalls and then continue to the KIBBUTZ GUEST HOUSE at HAGOSHRIM, for dinner and overnight.

Thursday : 24th May

Leave the Kibbutz and drive to the ancient city of Safad, to stroll through the artists' quarters and visit the synagogues. Continue via Kfar Kana to Nazareth. Visit the Church of Annunciation, Mary's Well, St. Joseph's Workshop and the oriental bazaars. Continue via Afula and Hadera to Natanya, and the GREENSTEIN HOTEL.

Friday : 25th May / Saturday : 26th May

At leisure in Natanya.

Sunday : 27th May

Leave Natanya and drive north along the coastal road to the ancient ruins of Caesarea. Continue to Haifa for a sightseeing tour, including the Bahai Temple and Gardens. On to the ancient port of Acre and then to Rosh Hanikra to view the caves and grottos. Return to Natanya.

Monday : 28th May / Tuesday : 29th May

At leisure in Natanya.

Wednesday : 30th May

Leave Natanya and drive via the Judean Mountains, bypassing Jerusalem to the shores of the Dead Sea and on to Ein Gedi and the Nahal David Waterfalls. Continue to Massada; ascend by cable car (and an 80-step climb) to view the famous Jewish fortress and Herodian Palace. Descend to the Dead Sea where time will be given for a short swim in the famous salt sea. Continue to the NOF ARAD HOTEL, ARAD, for dinner and overnight stay.

Thursday : 31st May

After breakfast, drive via Beersheba to Yad Mordechai to visit the model of a battlefield from the War of Liberation and the Museum. Continue to Ashkelon to view the Greek and Roman Antiquities and then on to the deep sea port of Ashdod. Visit the Rishon-le-Zion Wine Cellars and drive to Tel Aviv and the AMI HOTEL.

Friday : 1st June / Saturday : 2nd June

At leisure in Tel Aviv.

Sunday : 3rd June

Transfer to the Airport for departure by scheduled flight of El Al Israel Airlines, to London.
