**Proposed Itinerary of UK tour - 28th July to 3rd August**

One or two first class fully air-conditioned coaches (with two deaf interpreters) will take the participants to follow this itinerary :-

**28th July** - depart at 10.00 a.m. to reach Stratford-upon-Avon at 12.00. Visit Anne Hathaway's cottage and lunch there. Also visit the Shakespeare Theatre. Then an hour's walk around and shopping. Depart Stratford-upon-Avon at 18.00 for York. Dinner and overnight stay in York.

**29th July** - visit York Cathedral, Viking Museum (Jarvik Museum) and one hour walk around. Depart after lunch (approximately 14.00) for Edinburgh, Scotland. Dinner and overnight stay in Edinburgh.

**30th July** - visit the Royal Mile, Scott's Memorial and walk along Princes Street. Lunch. Depart at 14.00 for Loch Lomond and walk/drive around the loch. Dinner and overnight stay in Glasgow.

**31st July** - drive through Glasgow to the Lake District in time for lunch. Visit Grasmere, the home of William Wordsworth and take a boat trip across one of the lakes. Dinner and overnight stay in Grasmere.

**1st August** - depart for Wales via Chester - visit the slate mines, Snowdon Mountain and then dinner and overnight stay in Aberystwyth.

**2nd August** - depart in morning for Swansea for lunch. Then to Bath via Bristol. Dinner and overnight stay in Bath.

**3rd August** - Visit the Roman Baths and one hour's walk around. After lunch, depart for London.

Accommodation will be at AA-recommended 3-star hotels on bed/breakfast basis.

The anticipated costs per person will be approximately £255 (B/B accommodation plus full tour).
